Laps for Learning is our first annual jog-a-thon, which involves students walking and/or jogging around a designated area for one hour (1/2 hour for preschoolers).

The success of **Laps for Learning** is based on students bringing in names of people who are potential sponsors for the jog-a-thon. However, there is no “house-to-house” sign-up of potential sponsors. It is all done by filling in a label sheet of names. For every 15 names that a student brings in, our school should receive at least \$100.00 in contributions.

Potential sponsors may be family members, relatives, close friends, and neighbors. Special emphasis should be placed on out-of-state relatives and friends. Also, the people you do business with are a great source of names, i.e., barber, dentist, doctor, piano teacher, etc.

Our **Laps for Learning** will be held Friday, October 15, 2010.

“*Kick off*” information about **Laps for Learning** will be sent home with each student during the second week of school (five weeks before the jog-a-thon).

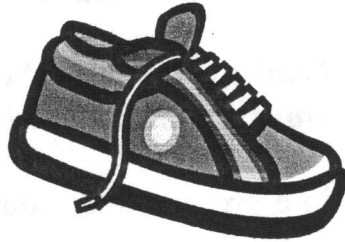

Our first annual **Laps for Learning** will take place on **Friday, October 15, 2010**. We will need plenty of volunteers to help ensure this event goes smoothly. There are four volunteer phases:

1. Kick-off Packet: 3-4 volunteers to print, put packet together, & place students name on packet.
2. Writing of the Mailers (2 groups):
 - Group 1 - Classroom volunteers: one parent each in the 1st and 2nd grade classrooms to assist teachers as students write their mailers.
 - Group 2 - Mailroom volunteers: 3-4 parents to proofread, fold, and stamp mailers. Also, write prefab mailers for preschool and kindergarten.
3. Event Day: 6-12 volunteers as follows,
 - track set-up
 - fill cup/water coolers with water
 - counting laps (marking lap cards)
 - collecting punch cards
